### **Camp Sealth**



#### Location

Camp Sealth encompasses 360 acres of forest, wetlands, and over a mile of saltwater beach on Colvos Passage. We are located on the southwest shore of Vashon Island, which is only accessible by ferry from Seattle, Tacoma, and Southworth (near Port Orchard). Groups must factor in transportation/ferry fees into their event. We are not able to provide a shuttle service to/from ferries.

#### **Important Things to Know Before Booking**

- All groups booking Camp Sealth must provide a certificate of insurance coverage for their group/organization or specifically for their event.
- Groups are allotted cabins based on the size of their group and only may use cabins allotted for them. An additional fee may apply if groups occupy additional cabins beyond those that can fit the capacity of their group. Individual rooms for guests are sometimes not possible. Please contact the Outdoor Education and Retreats director for additional information.
- Alcohol is allowed only for pre-approved events hosted by a MAST-licensed bartender with a banquet permit.
   Guests outside of the Group Leader or MAST-Licensed Bartender may not bring their own alcohol to be consumed on-site.
- Guests may not use any docks, boats (including personal boats) or enter the water from Camp Sealth unless supervised by a Camp Sealth lifeguard which requires an additional fee and may not be available at all times.

#### **Lodges & Meeting Spaces**

#### • Rounds Hall:

- The dining hall and main meeting room for the main camp area that can accommodate up to 400 people.
- Rounds Hall usage is included for main camp groups or can be rented separately.

#### • Parsons' Lodge:

- The dining room and main meeting room for Wrangler.
- Offers a small commercial-style kitchen for use by guests.
- o Can accommodate up to 60 people.
- Parsons' usage is included for Wrangler groups or can be rented separately.
- Additional small all-purpose spaces are available around Camp Sealth accommodating between 10-25 people each.
  - There will be an additional fee for any space used outside of your rented cabin unit(s).
- A small kitchenette with space for 2-3 people is also available in the main camp area.
